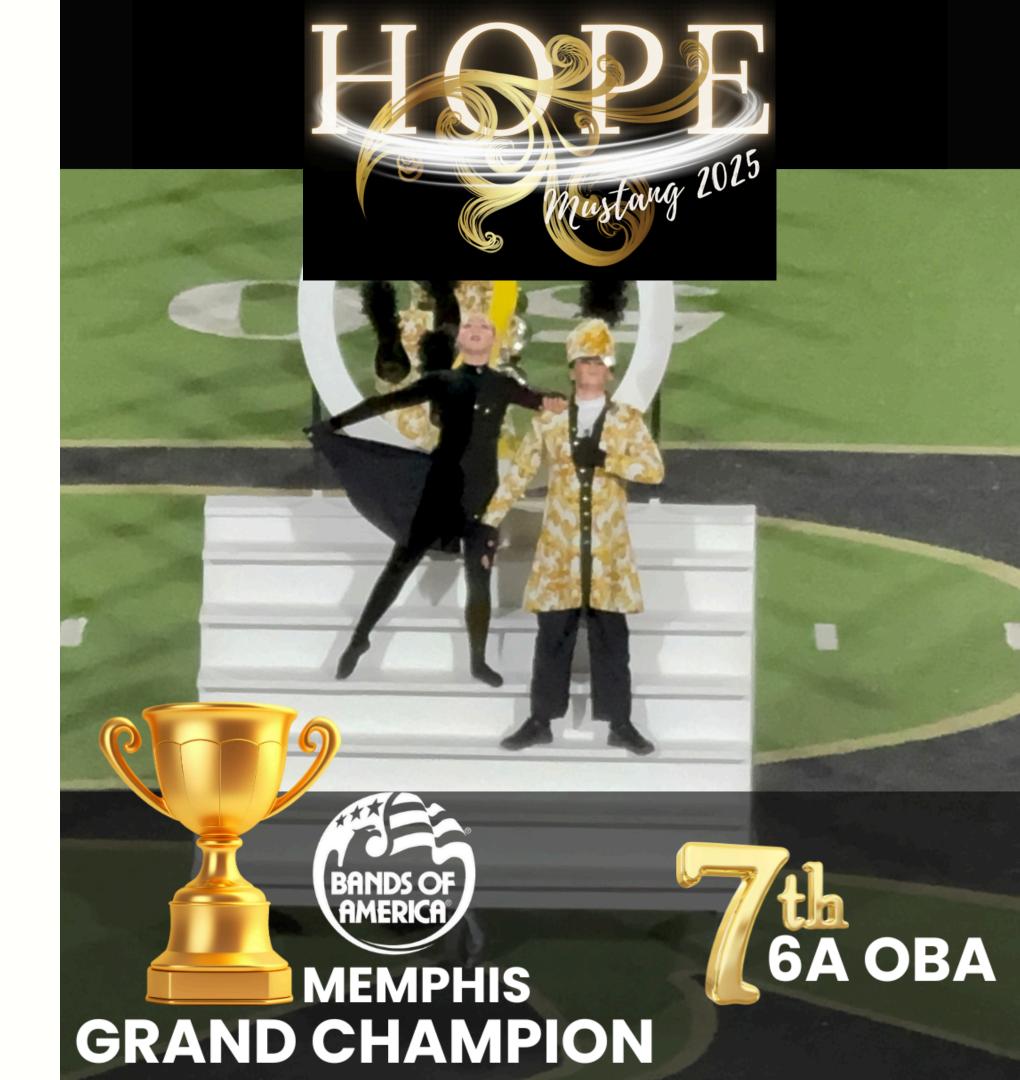

TREASURE REPORT

Kate Judd, Treasurer, went over the account totals through the end of September 30, 2025 YTD revenue and expenses were presented. Current account balance in checking \$48,965.53 Money Market \$526.92.- MMI income not included. YTD income and expenses reviewed. All reports can be reviewed online. 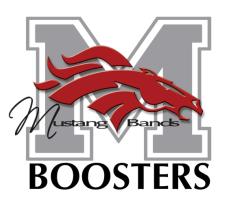

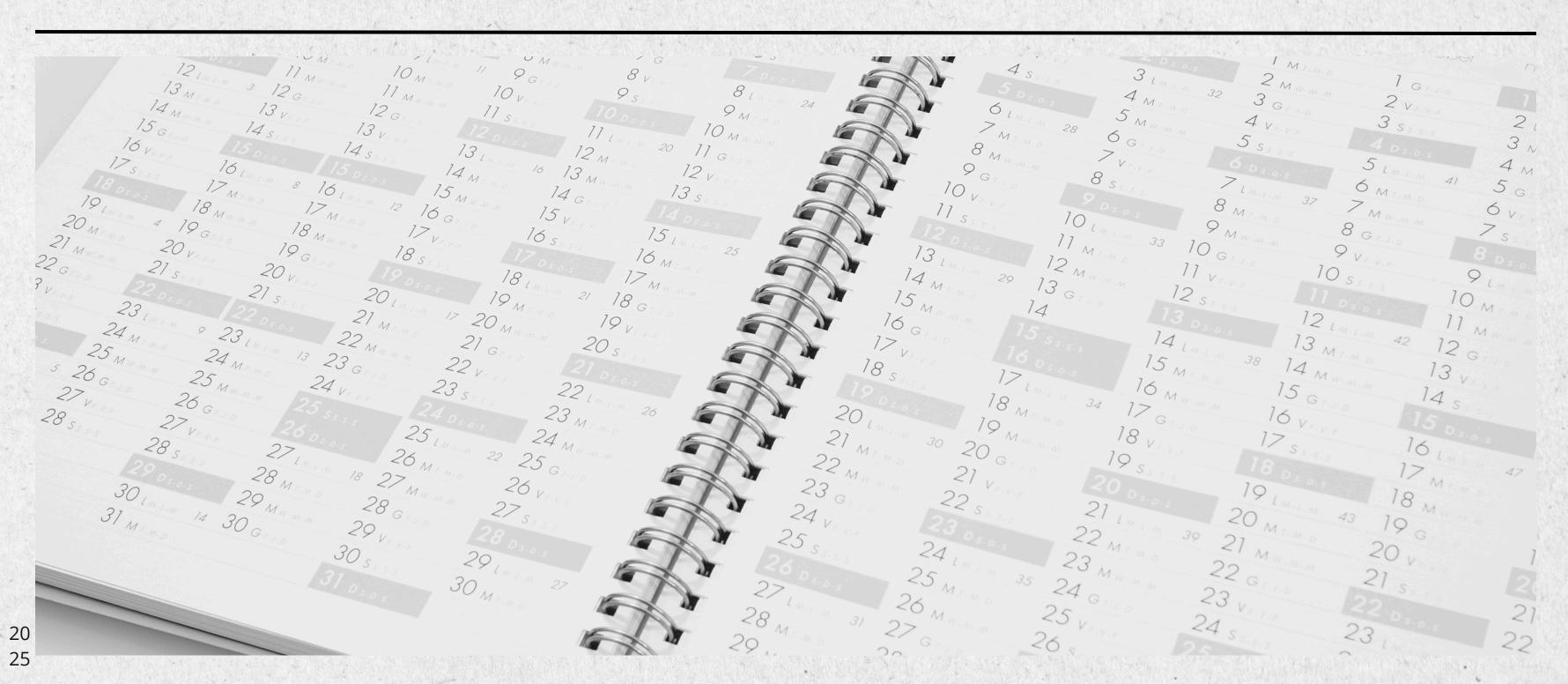


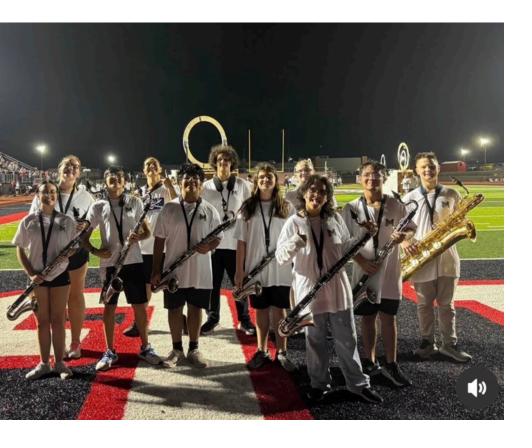
