Last quarter brought many fundraising efforts for our students. **Pecans, flowers and pies! OH MY!**

Around 40 students participated in this fundraiser which put more than \$3,000 into our student accounts for them to use for the Indy trip in March, to pay off their fall 2025 balances or to use for next marching season. We are so grateful that our students were able to capitalize off of this fundraiser!

We offered **flowers** for sale at the 1st hour band winter concert and I am proud to report that we sold out! That evening we sold more than \$450 of flowers to support our students.

The great 2025 **Pie Auction** was a HUGE success! We were just shy of \$900 in profit from our first ever Pie Auction.

The Mustang Fund For the Arts Hall of Fame Gala will be held on January 31, 2026 at our PAC.


