OLD BUSINESS

TREASURE REPORT

Kate Judd, treasurer, went over the account totals through February 2026, cash available, income and expenses. Current February account income -\$43,157.64, this is in part for the check written for the Indianapolis trip in March. Reimbursement from Hogan of \$8,200 is expected for overpayments made. After expenses, \$59,753.62 in total YTD profit. A check is expected back for about \$47332 for Indy reimbursement. Current checking balance \$46,694.01, \$526.86 MM. Cash available, \$48,286.34.

Motion to approve financials made by Kristin Richter. Approved by Bobby Lemaster and seconded by Shanelle Maxwell. All in favor, none opposed, motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS

-Bylaw Revision Vote presented by Robbynn Glinsmann- Active marching band booster members received a text message and an email with instructions to vote to pass the updated Bylaws. There is a 48-hour window to vote. All feedback was taken into consideration. These bylaws have not been updated in the last six years. The updated bylaws are succinct, thorough, guidelines that will guide the boosters in the next few years. They allow a smooth transition between positions within the booster club and board. According to current bylaws, a 2/3 vote from all active booster members is needed for the bylaws to pass. Thank you to Rachel Robins, Tyler Noland, Michelle LeMaster, Kate Judd, Shanelle Maxwell, Robbyn Glinsmann, Mr. Edgmon, for working the revision of the bylaws. If the vote does not pass, we will turn it around and start open.

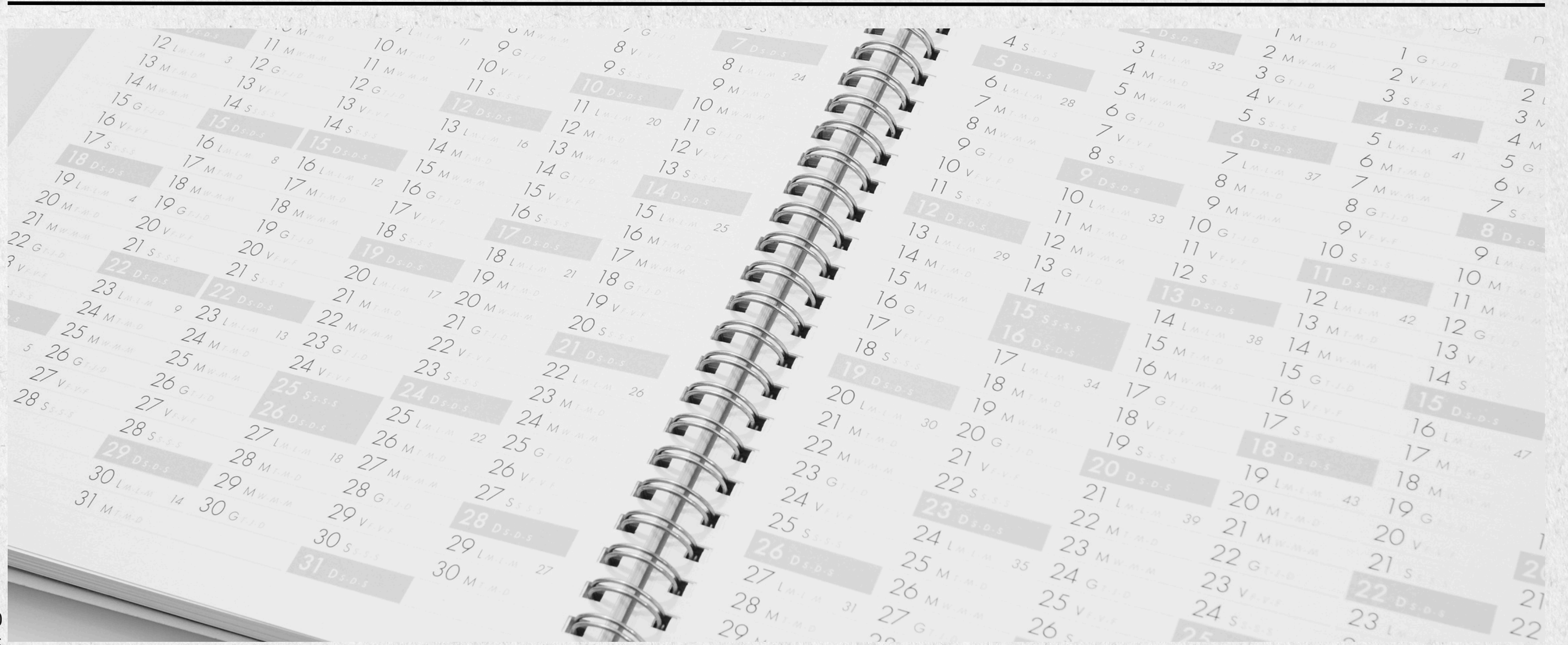

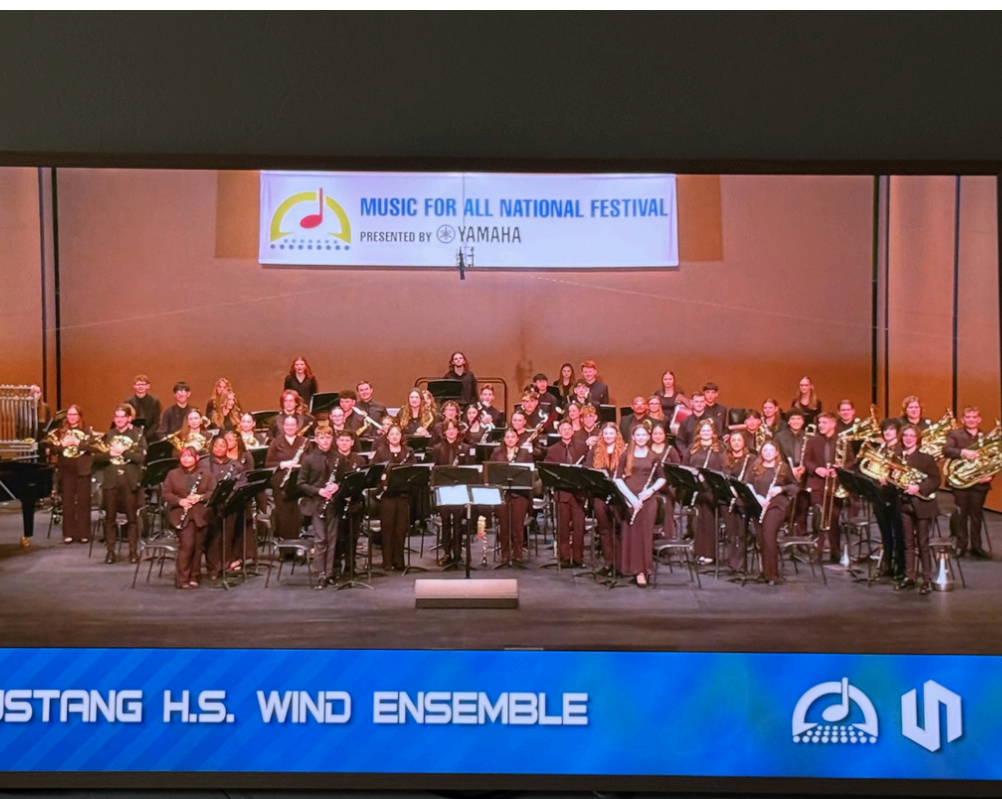

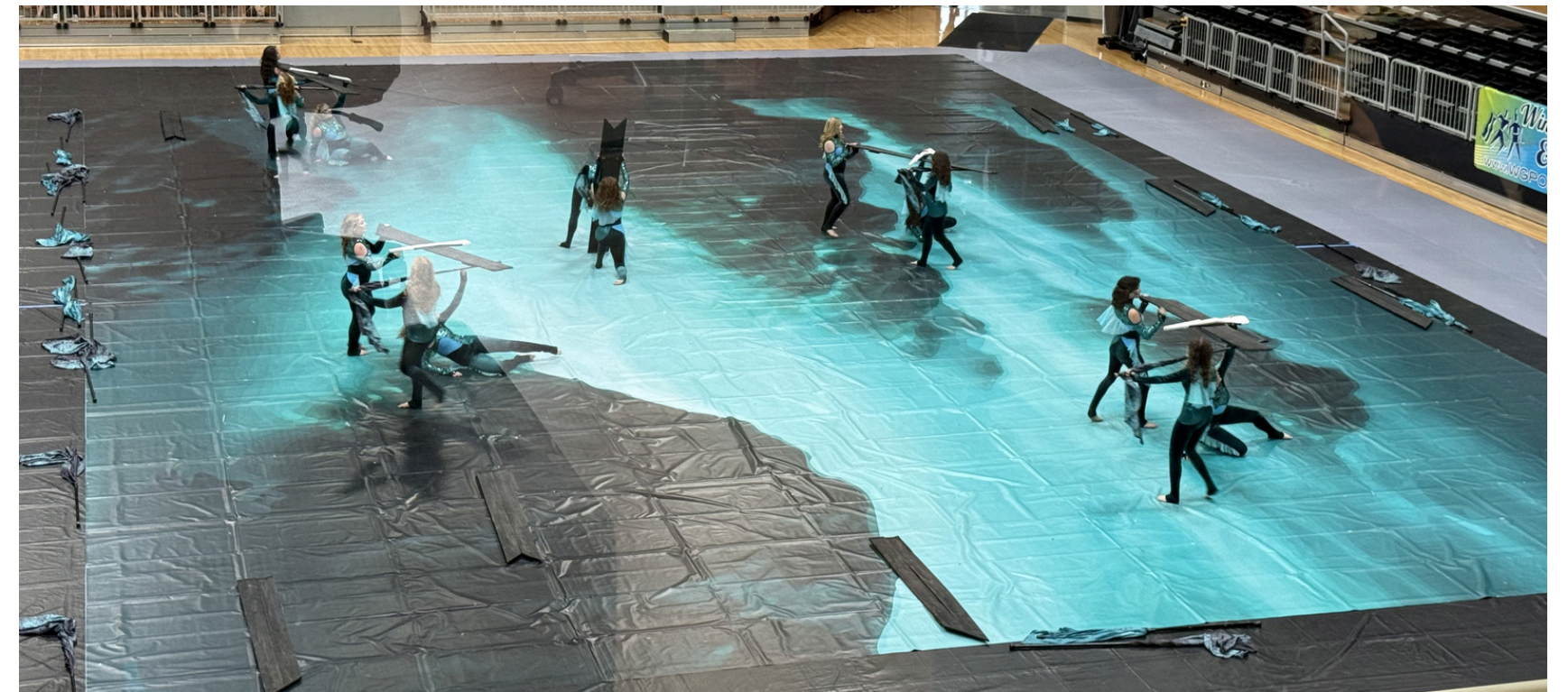
