OLD BUSINESS

Secretary's Report

Treasurer's Report

Kate Judd, treasurer, reviewed the current financial report. Initial firework sales topped 70k this year with around 30k profit! Show expenses and the beginning of concessions this month will cause a dip in the account but positive sales in concessions and the movement deeper into marching season should see things level out.

NEW BUSINESS

Booster By-Law Updates

The updates to booster by-laws were presented as a reminder to the membership: Membership shall be open to parents/guardians of students active in any Mustang High School band program; Each member in good standing is entitled to one vote on matters presented to the membership. A member in good standing shall be defined as a member who has current dues paid in full, complies with the organization's bylaws and the school district's code of conduct, has not had their membership rights suspended or revoked by the Executive Board, and has attended at least two booster meetings per semester; To be eligible to serve as an officer or board member, an individual must be a current member in good standing of the Booster Club and must maintain active membership throughout their term. If the executive member's student(s) are no longer active in any of the MHS Band Programs, the executive member must vacate their position. A replacement shall be elected at the following booster meeting. To be eligible to be elected as a booster officer, a member must have been in good standing the previous year; Regular membership meetings shall be held in-person monthly, with a minimum of nine (9) meetings per year. Regularly scheduled meetings are on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:30 PM in the band room. Meetings may be cancelled, rescheduled, or moved to a virtual format at the discretion of the executive board.

Monthly in-person board meetings will be streamed for informational purposes only. Participating in the streamed meeting does not count as attending the meeting.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Rachel also reviewed the CFA fundraiser and the upcoming mattress fundraiser. The mattress guy will speak at community preview night and the actual sale is 8/30 from 10am-5pm.

Rachel reviewed the 30/60/90 calendar and adjusted the next booster meeting date from 9/1 to 9/8. The band will be serving at the Regional Food Bank on 9/1 with the Yukon marching band, and the drumlines are going to compete--media will be present, too!
