OPENING BUSINESS

Secretary's Report

Treasurer, Kate Judd, presented the current financial report. The booster account balance has begun to increase as fall fundraising activities get underway.

Concessions have started, with approximately \$4,000 in profit generated from the first Monday of operation.

Year-to-date income and expenses were reviewed, including concession expenses, food for students, and MMI-related income. Financial reports are available on the Mustang Band Boosters website, mustangbandboosters.com.

Members were reminded that each family is required to provide at least one volunteer for MMI. MMI volunteer shifts are not paid, as they are considered service to the band program.

A motion was made by President Shanelle Maxwelle to approve the financial report. Approved by Melissa Marschall and seconded by Kristin Richter. Motion passed.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The Director's Report included several updates regarding the marching season and upcoming travel. An indoor rehearsal opportunity at the OEV indoor facility in the Springfield area was discussed for October 10, pending final contract confirmation.

Mr. Edgmon also discussed potential changes to the Grand Nationals travel schedule. The current plan is to depart Wednesday morning, rehearse in the Springfield area, travel to Indianapolis on Thursday, and rehearse in Indianapolis prior to Friday's performance. The change is expected to have a minimal impact on cost and will reduce some expenses associated with relay drivers and additional travel.

Chaperone information will be distributed once the travel arrangements are finalized. Mr. Edgmon plans to begin with individuals who previously expressed interest in chaperoning.

A Friday evening meal for students and families during Grand Nationals was discussed. The group expressed interest in having a shared meal where families could join the students.

Questions were also addressed regarding AED availability and medical support. Staff members have been trained on AED use, and AED units provide step-by-step instructions when activated. Medical personnel will also be available at competitions, games, and other major rehearsals/events.

Additional information was provided regarding parade logistics, including the anticipated meeting location, student arrival time, road closures, parking, and parent pickup.

The next Booster meeting will be held on October, 6 2026 in the band room. Motion to Adjourn made by Shanelle Maxwell, approved by Kristin Richter and seconded by Tarressa Cosson. Approved.
